






KIDNAPPERS








Dred Scott

- 1857: Dred Scott sues for his freedom, but is told by the Supreme Court that he cannot do so. The reason they give him? He is not actually a citizen. He is property in the eyes of the government.
- "A free negro of the African race, whose ancestors were brought to this country and sold as slaves, is not a "citizen" within the meaning of the Constitution of the United States." Scott v. Sanford.
